Shalimar Little League is committed to providing a safe, positive, and instructional environment for all players. Coaches serve as leaders, role models, and representatives of the league and are expected to promote sportsmanship, respect, safety, and a love of the game in alignment with Little League Baseball® principles.

By serving as a coach, you agree to the following:

1. Sportsmanship and Leadership

- Act as a positive role model and represent Shalimar Little League with integrity and respect.
- Place player safety, well-being, and development above winning.
- Promote fair play, teamwork, and respect for all participants.

2. Conduct and Language

- Use respectful language and behavior at all games, practices, and league events.
- Profanity, inappropriate gestures, yelling at, or demeaning players, umpires, parents, or opponents is prohibited.
- Address concerns calmly and through proper league channels.

3. Substances

- Tobacco products, vaping, alcohol, and illegal substances are prohibited at any/all Shalimar Little League activities (practices, games, league events).
- Coaches shall never be under the influence while representing the league.

4. Player Safety and Fair Play

- Follow all Shalimar Little League and Little League International rules.
- Treat all players fairly and provide equal opportunities to learn and participate.
- Bullying, harassment, or intimidation will not be tolerated.

5. Accountability

- Failure to comply with this Code may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or removal, as determined by the Board of Directors.
